

Booth Specifications

The dimensions of the booth is W3,000mm x D3,000mm. Octanorm Panels (W990mm x H2,700mm/panel) are set for standard booth. Decoration and display can only be placed within the confines of your booth space.

•Exhibition registration fee: JPY143,000 for non-members only (free for supporting members)


·Booth charges: JPY387,000 per 9m square unit

- •Exhibitor Presentation application fee (optional): JPY51,000 per slot




Booth Configuration





Application Process

- 1. Please fill in the inquiry form to request the application contract (PDF data) from the official website < https://www.gesuidouten.jp/ >
- 2. SEWAGE WORKS EXHIBITION Secretariat Office will send you the application contract by e-mail.
- 3. Please fill in and send the application contract and your product catalogue by e-mail to the SEWAGE WORKS EXHIBITION Secretariat Office.
- 4. Upon receipt of the completed application contract, the Organizer will send an invoice.
- 5. The net amount must be remitted by electronic transfer to the designated account of the Organizer at one transaction by May 10 (Fri.), 2024. Applicants are not considered to be exhibitors until payment has been confirmed by the Organizer.

Cancellation

From the date which the notification of application acceptance is sent out, the cancellation fee must be paid, if an exhibitor cancels an application for any reason, or reduces the number of applied booths.

•Cancellation received by May 10 (Fri.), 2024 : 70% of participation fees.

•Cancellation received after May 11 (Sat.), 2024 : 100% of participation fees.

Decision on the Locations of Exhibition Spaces

The Organizer will decide the basic arrangement, layout of the venue, and assign the locations of the exhibitors by taking into consideration the number of exhibitors and exhibition space. Please note that requests for exhibiting locations may not be accommodated.
